
Type C - Tenant Improvement/Remodel to Existing Building


Type A - Demolition/ Retrofit of Existing Building


Compilation of Community Provided Data

Discovery

Using the library to foster learning and discovery by providing blended indoor and outdoor environments, various sizes of reading spaces throughout the library, activity and meeting rooms, and modern technology and resources. The library should encourage social interaction by creating an opportunity for users to occupy and discover the library differently each time they visit. Visual and physical connections to the adjacent open space to the south and west of the library creates an opportunity for users to discover the natural elements of Los Osos.











<u>elements</u>

- -meandering site path that allow users to discover outdoor spaces
- -floor plan to allow unique circulation through the library
- -variety of unique private seating (nooks)
- -variety of unique group seating
- -community artist discovery area
- -indoor and outdoor areas for children to discover




