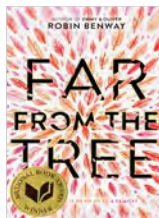

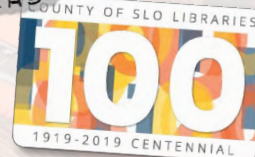

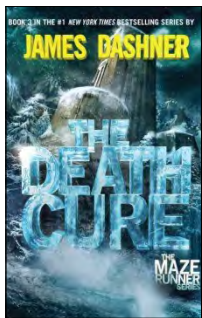

The Maze Runner: the Death Cure by James Dashner

WICKED has taken everything from Thomas: his life, his memories, and now his only friends—the Gladers. It's finally over. The trials are complete, after one final test. What WICKED doesn't know is that Thomas remembers far more than they think, and it's enough to prove that he can't believe a word of what they say. Thomas beat the Maze. He survived the Scorch. He'll risk anything to save his friends. But the truth might be what ends it all. The time for lies is over. The film adaptation of *The Maze Runner: The Death Cure* hits the big screen on January 26th.

City of Ember (Ember, book 1) by Jeanne DuPrau

The city of Ember was built as a last refuge for the human race. Two hundred years later, the great lamps that light the city are beginning to flicker. When Lina finds part of an ancient message, she's sure it holds a secret that will save the city. She and her friend Doon must decipher the message before the lights go out on Ember forever!

Reason: Teens seeking ways out of a life seemingly without hope are at the heart of both fast-paced sci-fi series. The Books of Ember series is for slightly younger readers. (from Novelist)



Lockdown (Escape from Furnace, book 1) by Alexander Gordon Smith

When fourteen-year-old Alex is framed for murder, he becomes an inmate in the Furnace Penitentiary, where brutal inmates and sadistic guards reign, boys who disappear in the middle of the night sometimes return weirdly altered, and escape might just be possible.

Reason: In each of these series, imprisoned teens struggle to survive in bleak circumstances -- and the threats they face are always changing. Heart-pounding, page-turning reads, the books in these series are somewhat violent and disturbing. (from Novelist)



Virals (Virals, book 1) by Kathy Reichs

Tory Brennan is the leader of a band of teenage 'sci-philes' who live on an island off the coast of South Carolina and when the group rescues a dog caged for medical testing, they are exposed to an experimental strain of canine parvovirus that changes their lives forever.

Reason: Questionable science experimentation is one of the themes explored in both suspenseful, action-packed series. Readers will enjoy getting to know the groups of teens who band together as they try to overcome adverse situations. (from Novelist)
