Youth Ride Free is a Rideshare program that allows K-12 students to take the bus for free during summer months. No pass is required. Students simply present their student ID to the driver (when they've been issued one – for younger students this may not apply).

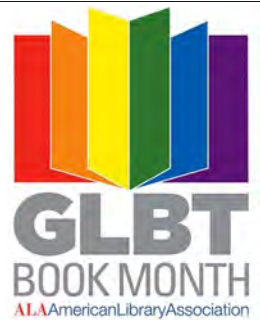
