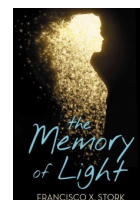
The Square Root of Summer by Harriet Reuter Hapgood

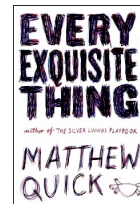
The Memory of Light by Francisco X. Stork
